TO ALL TO WHOM THESE PRESENTS SHALL COME, GREETING:

**Know ye,** That *Thomas Bennett*, of  
*Scioto County, Ohio* —  
having deposited in the Treasury a certificate of the Register of the Land-office at *Chillicothe*  
whereby it appears that he has made full payment for the  
South East quarter of Lot or Section Number Five, of  
Township Number Four, in Range Number Twenty  
two (*Langham's Survey*) —

— of the lands directed to be sold at *Chillicothe* —  
by the act of Congress, entitled "An act providing for the sale of the lands of the United  
States in the territory north-west of the Ohio, and above the mouth of Kentucky river,"  
and of the acts amendatory of the same, There is granted, by the United States, unto  
the said *Thomas Bennett* the quarter — lot or section —  
of land above described; To have and to hold the said quarter — lot or  
section — of land, with the appurtenances, unto the said *Thomas*  
*Bennett* His — heirs and assigns forever.

In testimony whereof, I have caused these letters to be made Patent,  
and the seal of the United States to be hereunto affixed.
