TO ALL TO WHOM THESE PRESENTS SHALL COME, GREETING:

Know ye, That *Thomas Bennett* Assignee of
Reuben Bumgarner

having deposited in the General Land-Office, a Certificate of the Register of the Land-Office
 at *Chillicothe* whereby it appears that full payment has been made for

the southeast quarter of section Six of township
 Four in range Twenty two (Langhams Survey)

of the lands directed to be sold at *Chillicothe*
 by the Act of Congress, entitled "An Act providing for the sale of the lands of the United
 States in the Territory north-west of the Ohio, and above the mouth of Kentucky river," and
 of the Acts amendatory of the same: There is granted, by the United States, unto the
 said *Thomas Bennett* the quarter lot or
 section of land above described: To have and to hold the said quarter
 lot or section of land, with the appurtenances, unto said *Thomas Bennett*
his heirs and assigns for ever.
