

TO ALL TO WHOM THESE PRESENTS SHALL COME, GREETING:

Know ye, That Jesse Huff of Ross County,

having deposited in the Treasury a certificate of the Register of the Land-office at Chillicothe, whereby it appears that he has made full payment for the Southwest Quarter of Section number Twenty seven, of Township number Five, in Range number Twenty one.



of the lands directed to be sold at Chillicothe, by the act of Congress, entitled "An act providing for the sale of the lands of the United States in the territory north-west of the Ohio, and above the mouth of Kentucky river," and of the acts amendatory of the same, There is granted, by the United States, unto the said Jesse Huff, the Quarter, lot or section of land above described: To have and to hold the said Quarter, lot or section of land, with the appurtenances, unto the said Jesse Huff his heirs and assigns forever.

In testimony whereof, I have caused these letters to be made Patent, and the seal of the United States to be hereunto affixed.
