

JAMES F. HUFF DIES THURSDAY AT HIS HOME HERE

James Franklin Huff, 72, died at his home, 3223 Avenue J, Thursday night at 9:15 o'clock, following an illness of four months.

He was born in Lincoln, Ill., on January 17, 1860. Mr. Huff had been a resident of this city for the past 17 years. He was a carpenter by trade.

He was united in marriage to Henryetta Lowman on January 21, 1886, at Lincoln, Ill. He was a member of the Christian church at Gorin, Mo., and also was a member of the Carpenters' union No. 373.

He is survived by two sons, Wil-

ber Huff, Fort Madison, Iowa, and Walter Huff, Denver, Colo.; two daughters, Mrs. John J. Karle and Mrs. Leonard Kokjohn, both of Fort Madison, Iowa; one brother, David Huff, Lincoln, Ill.; one sister, Mrs. J. W. Shilling, Lincoln, Ill.; four grandchildren, Harriet and Mildred Kokjohn, and Ruth Helen Karle, Fort Madison, and Jerold Huff, Detroit, Mich.

Funeral services will be held Sunday afternoon at Clements chapel at 2:30. Noel T. Adams, minister of the Christian church, will officiate.

Interment will be made in Oakland cemetery.

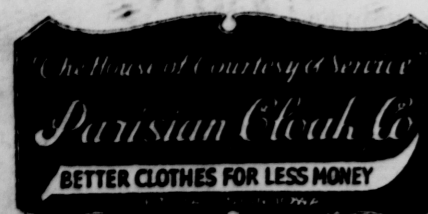
