JAMES MONROE, President of the United States of America,
TO ALL TO WHOM THESE PRESENTS SHALL COME, GREETING:

Know ye, That Abraham Huff of Pike county Ohio

having deposited in the **General Land Office**, a Certificate of the Register of the **Land Office** at *Chillicothe* whereby it appears that full payment has been made for *the South East quarter of section n^o five, in township five, of Range twenty, containing one hundred and fifty nine acres and fifty one hundredths.*

of the Lands directed to be sold at *Chillicothe* by the Act of Congress, entitled "An act providing for the sale of the lands of the United States in the territory north-west of the **Ohio**, and above the mouth of Kentucky river," and of the acts amendatory of the same: **There is granted**, by the United States, unto the said *Abraham Huff* the *quarter* lot or section of Land above described: **To have and to hold** the said *quarter* lot or section of Land, with the Appurtenances, unto the said *Abraham Huff* *his* heirs and assigns forever.

In Testimony whereof, I have caused these letters to be made **Patent**, and the seal of the General Land-Office to be hereunto affixed.

Given under my hand at the City of Washington, the *seventh* day of *May* in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and *twenty one* and of the Independence of the United States of America, the forty *fifth*.
