

# \$7,500,000 Primary Road Bond Payments Are Approved

## WILL REDUCE BONDS' AMOUNT

### Cerro Gordo County Retires All Its Outstanding Bonds

AMES, Apr. 18.—The Iowa State Highway Commission Saturday announced it had approved payment of \$7,500,000 in principal and interest for county primary road bonds falling due in May.

The commission approved the payment of \$6,000,000 in principal and interest on \$10,000,000 of bonds issued in 1934 and 1935. It also approved the payment of \$1,500,000 in principal and interest on \$2,000,000 of bonds issued in 1936 and 1937. The commission also approved the payment of \$100,000 in principal and interest on \$1,000,000 of bonds issued in 1938 and 1939.

The May 1 payment will reduce the amount of bonds outstanding to \$2,500,000 and high annual amortization of \$1,000,000 to leave the full amount retired by May 1, 1942. The date that the full amount is retired will depend on the amount of the state highway fund, which is estimated to be \$10,000,000 in 1942.
