Harry Crittenden Dead

Harry L. Crittenden died at his home at Manum, Oklahoma, March 29, 1913, in his 56th year. Mr. Crittenden was well known in Paola in earlier years, having been raised here. His father, L. C. Crittenden, who died in Oklahoma several years ago, was a pioneer citizen of Paola and was postmaster there about 1884. Harry was holding member of the younger society. He was born on Iowa October 6, 1857. His parents came to Kansas in early days and Harry grew up here. The family moved from Paola to Lane and Harry's father was elected postmaster of Paola. He was also judge of Franklin County, April 25, 1888. Harry was married to Annie, the daughter of Miss Caroline J. Goodrich, a niece of Col. J. West Goodrich, the well known Paola newspaper man. Mr. Crittenden published a daily newspaper at Paola, a number of years, and in 1910, he located at Manum, Oklahoma, where he engaged in the newspaper business. He was appointed postmaster at Manum, which office he held at his death.
